


The hardware

Scenic hikes

Use your time-out for a leisurely winter walk and explore the surrounding region, one step at a time. When the fields and meadows sparkle in cool white and the snow crunches under your feet, you can experience the peaceful, pristine side of the Seefeld mountain plateau.

With a total of 142 km of cleared and signposted trails, the Olympic region is the perfect hideaway for all hikers. Whether down in the valley or up in the mountains – the paths crisscross their way through Seefeld, offering sweeping panoramic views. Surrounded by a wonderful winter landscape, this is the ideal opportunity to pause, slow down and enjoy the moment to the fullest.

Outdoor highlights in the snow

For snow enthusiasts, the Olympic region Seefeld offers seven special routes extending over 35 km in total. This means that you can explore the rough terrain yourself and discover some remote spots. Our hiking guide Fabian Kikl offers special **trial snowshoe hikes** every Thursday from November/December, provided there is sufficient snow. From 05:00 – 06:30 pm, everyone sets off together from the ASTORIA RESORT up the Geigenbühel hill towards the Birkenlift ski resort and through the snowy forest.

Another highlight: The evening **torchlight hikes**, which take place every Saturday from November between 05:30 – 06:30 pm. Surrounded by a mystical winter atmosphere, Fabian will accompany you from the ASTORIA towards the Triendsäge forest inn and through the snow-covered, fairytale-like forest. The one-hour walk in the torchlight is the highlight among the winter hikes and one of the most adventure-packed days of your vacation in nature.

Cross-country skiing paradise

The unmistakable Nordic lifestyle of the Olympic region attracts both pleasure cross-country skiers and professional athletes. Situated on a sunny mountain plateau at 1,200 m, Seefeld offers everything a cross-country skiing enthusiast could desire. Around 245 km of perfectly groomed cross-country skiing trails and a variety of routes in all level of difficulty offer a wide range of sporting experience. You can try out both the classic and skating styles on the **special cross-country trails** – with your four-legged friend on the **dogs' trail** or under the spotlights in the evening on the **night-time trail**. There are also routes with **barrier-free access** for adaptive and wheelchair skiing.


The Olympic region Seefeld is a top-quality destination for cross-country skiing, as confirmed by the awarded Tyrolean cross-country seal of quality. Information panels along all routes and the world's only cross-country ski track rescue concept allow guests to have carefree fun outdoors in nature. Thanks to its geographical location, the region also has one of the highest levels of snowfall in Austria. Starting in November, it's time for cross-country skiing in the heart of Tyrol, where the world champions get together.



Ski slopes with breathtaking views

The Olympic region Seefeld is not only popular among cross-country enthusiasts, it also offers excellent conditions for alpine skiers. With 26 km of slopes and 34 modern cable cars over a total area of 600,000 m² action-packed fun is guaranteed. The optimal slope conditions have attracted renowned ski stars such as **Lindsey Vonn** or **Maria Höfl-Riesch** to Seefeld. The region is therefore an insider tip for skiers and snowboarders, who appreciate its varied, sunny terrain.

Both beginners and advanced skiers will feel at home in the different areas. The multiple award-winning ski area Rosshütte at 2,064 m offers breath-taking views and a wide range of descents. The panoramic Gschwandtkopf ski resort is popular among both guests and professional teams, who can be seen training on the lower steep slope. Leutasch, Neuleutasch, Geigenbühel and Birkenlift are also particularly idyllic and family friendly ski resorts. Unique panoramic mountain views are, of course, included.
